

VISA FOR FILMING

- Short term visa (less than or equal to 90 days) or long term visa
- Impossibility to obtain a visa for filming without temporary authorization of filming

List of documents to be provided:

- Passport (1)
- Copy of passport
- Recent identity photo (3.5cm x 4.5cm) to be pasted on the form
- Copy of return ticket or proof of reservation
- Stamp at 3.60 € (for applicant living in Germany) or prepaid 0.5kg DHL or UPS
- Proof of payment of visa fees
- Certificate of residence (less than 3 months)
- Police record (less than 3 months)
- Certificate of yellow fever vaccination (2)
- Temporary authorization of filming (3)

Possibility of request of additional documents

- (1) valid for at least 6 months after the expected date of arrival in Madagascar
- (2) for visitors who have stayed the last six days in countries infected by this disease , according to WHO recommendations
- (3) delivered by O.MA.CI. (Malagasy Office of Cinéma)

→ **Any project of filming on the territory of Madagascar is submitted to the obtention of an authorization, delivered by O.MA.CI. through payment of filming fees.**

→ **The file for request of authorization of filming must be directly addressed to OMACI, accompanied with the following documents:**

- Request of authorization of filming (form to be completed)
- Technical sheet of the film (form to be completed)
- Synopsis of the film
- List of the materials of filming
- List of the filming team, with their qualification and copy of their passport
- Information concerning the main person in charge of the filming
- Certificate of existence of the company of production

→ **A temporary authorization of filming will be then delivered by OMACI, after deposit of the file.**
